### EO Requirements and COVID-19 Preparedness Plans Requirements Guidance for Seated Recreational Entertainment and Meetings

Professional Testing/Licensure: Venues are permitted to host in-person training, testing, examinations, and other activities that are necessary for occupational certification, licensure, or to meet a requirement to conduct a trade or business. Venues and administrators of training, testing, examinations and other activities that are necessary for occupational licensure or certifications are encouraged to offer remote or virtual options wherever possible and must follow the guidance and Preparedness Plan requirements.

**The venue will have double-triple classroom capacity than in previous years to ensure safe distancing throughout the day. Meals will be served to each participant at the classroom table. The LIVE expo will not be available for 2021.**

According to the Minnesota Dept. of Labor and Industry, applicants for renewal of the following individual electrical licenses must have earned 16 hours of approved continuing education credit to renew their license:

Class A Master Electrician	Class B Master Electrician
Class A Journeyman Electrician	Class B Journeyman Electrician
Power Limited Technician	Class A Installer
Master Elevator Constructor	Elevator Constructor
Class B Installer	Maintenance Electrician

The licenses identified above cannot be renewed unless the license holder has earned 16 hours of continuing education credit within the license term immediately preceding their license expiration date, or until 16 hours of credit is earned and license renewal fees are paid. **Individuals who fail to renew their license by the expiration date are unlicensed until they submit their renewal form and fee, and the license is issued by the Construction Codes and Licensing Division.** Licenses that are not renewed before the expiration date are subject to a late fee equal to one year's license fee. License anniversary dates (effective dates) do not change based on date of renewal. Licensees who fail to renew their licenses within two years beyond expiration are required to retake an examination to regain licensure in accordance with Minnesota Statute 326.242, Subd. 7. Credits may be used for more than one type of license if earned in the overlap period of the license terms. Credits totaling more than the minimum 16 hours cannot be carried over into subsequent license terms.
